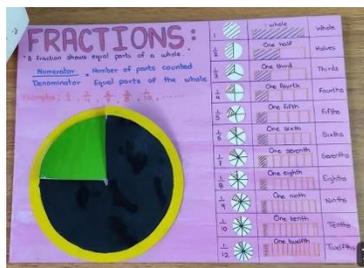
- Collect some Educational pictures from any newspaper or any old book, paste these in A-4 size sheet & ready a creative project and write at least 4 or 5 Lines about each.

### **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY**



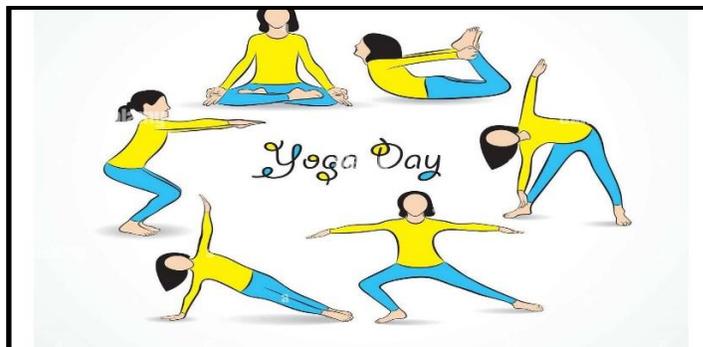
#### **➤ Instructions to follow:**
