WORLD ENVIORNMENT DAY



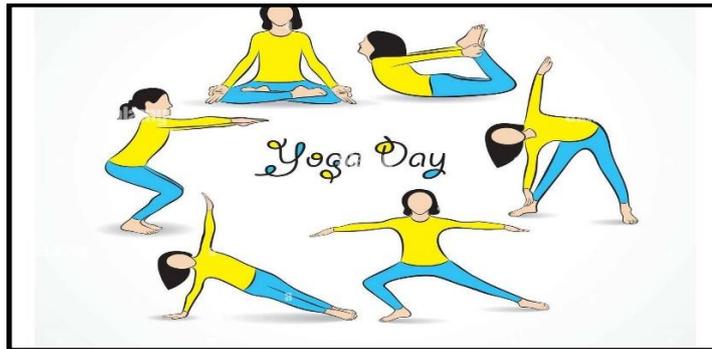
➤ **Instructions to follow:**
